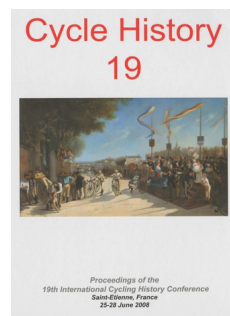

Each conference is organized by a different group, institution, or individual. After each conference the proceedings are published.
